 - ▶ Reclamation of upland sites using rough soil surface (Piceance basin restoration study; September 2020)
- ▶ “P” of CPW along with CMU reference success of seeding at Connected Lakes
- ▶ Weed inventory completed by interns
 - ▶ 2016
- ▶ Weed inventory completed by CPW 2019



Leveraged resources

- ▶ CPW
 - ▶ Personnel and Equipment
- ▶ WCCC
 - ▶ Crews hired by REW and Crews hired by CPW. Funded by GOCO
- ▶ REW
 - ▶ Technical expertise
 - ▶ Strike Teams
 - ▶ Recruitment of volunteer labor



Leveraged financial support

- ▶ CPW
 - ▶ CPW wetlands grants
 - ▶ CPW operating dollars “parks cash”
- ▶ REW
 - ▶ Multiple grants supporting over \$250,000 in reclamation on CPW properties since 2011
- ▶ TRWC
 - ▶ Newly formed entity with focus on reducing fire severity within Mesa County
- ▶ One Riverfront
 - ▶ Efforts to enhance natural condition of river corridor
